
Campaign Rules

These are additional rules to the Rules and Regulations of Cercle des Élèves de l'École des Mines d'Alès. It gives the terms and conditions of the election a new Bureau des Élèves and the rules that must be followed by any candidate to the election. The elections of Bureau de Sports and of Bureau des Arts follow the same terms and conditions.

Article 1 – Election system

Two candidate lists apply for the election. A list is composed of all the members who apply to be part of the new board. Both lists have one campaign week to convince the electors. Votes will be open for at least 48 hours. The results and the number of voters will be announced publicly by one of the means of communication of Cercle.

Article 2 – Composition of a list

A candidate list must have at least 20 members, at most 25 for the BDS and BDA and at most 30 for the BDE.

Article 3 – Creation of a list

If someone wishes to start creating a list, they must contact the outgoing President to be sure that 2 lists have not already been created. A list is considered formed and will be candidate as soon as it has 15 members whose names should be given to the outgoing president. The outgoing board keeps the right to ask for a justification of the seriousness of the two first lists formed to confirm their participation in the campaigns. When the list is formed, information about the campaigns, details about the board's roles to assign and some additional rules to follow will be communicated.

The name of the list's president must be given to the outgoing president at least 6 weeks before the beginning of the campaign week, the ones of the vice-presidents, treasurers and secretaries at least 4 weeks before and the ones of all the members of the list with their roles at least 2 weeks before.

Article 4 – Double listing

Double listing is where someone belongs to more than one list, for the same board or not, and it is not allowed. Anyone who is part of different lists will automatically be forbidden from being in any list.

Article 5 – Dates of campaign weeks

The dates of the campaign weeks will be given by Cercle des Élèves through one of its means of communication.

Article 6 – Communication outside of the campaign week

A list must stay secret until the beginning of the campaign week. Before this date, the name, the logo, the composition and any other information about the list must stay confidential outside of that list.

All communication for a campaign by the lists must be done during the campaign week. Any form of communication is forbidden during the voting period.

Article 7 – Events organisation

Throughout the week, three slots will be given to each list for them to organise their afterwork, party and activities. The parties must take place on friday and saturday evenings.

The afterwork and the party must take place in the Salle de Boum or SdB. The rent of the SdB and the loan of equipment follow the same terms and conditions than those written in the article 8 of Clubs Rules, additional rules n°1 to the Rules and Regulations.

Article 8 – Communication

Cercle des Élèves reserves the right to examine the publications done by a list and can decide to ask the removal of a publication that is judged as harmful or dangerous to the association.

Article 9 – Campaign accounts

Campaign accounts must be held by each list and presented to the outgoing board at the end of the campaign week. They must be published on request of the outgoing board or of Cercle des élèves.

Article 10 – Partnerships

The partnerships made by a list can't be opposed to those taken by Cercle des élèves. It is forbidden to promise or take a partnership in the name of Cercle.

Article 11 – Campaigns and school

Any activity within the scope of campaigns is forbidden during lessons, be it by, or for, a student that currently has class.

Article 12 – Votes

Votes are open to all members of Cercle des Élèves for the BDE and BDS campaigns,

and to all members of the BDS for campaign of BDS.

Article 13 – Abiding to the rules and sanctions

These additional rules must be signed by every list's president. By signing, the president commits to following and having his list's members follow these rules. In the case of one of these articles being broken by a member of a list, Cercle des Élèves can decide to enforce several sanctions going from a simple warning to the disqualification of a list for the campaigns in case of endangerment of Cercle des Élèves, IMT Mines Alès or Mines Alès Alumni.
